Guidelines for the oral presentation and written report

- The presentation has to be given in **English** and should last **no more than 45 minutes** (including discussion).
- The presentation should be prepared in **Beamer for LaTeX**.
- The report has to be **written in English using LaTeX** and should be no longer than **10 pages** (excluding title, table of contents, references) in 11pt.
- Deadline for handing in the written reports is four weeks after the oral presentation.
- Everything presented in the talk should be documented in the report (including proofs!).
- Proofs that are not given in the references have not to be carried out. If only the idea of a proof is mentioned, this is also sufficient for the report. However, possibly missing intermediate steps of given proofs should be carried out.
- Citations should refer to the respective scientific publications, see MathSciNet.

Grading

- To be eligible for a graded certificate a registration in the examination office (Prüfungsamt) is required **before the date of the oral presentation**.
- Grading: the **oral presentation** counts about 40% of your grade, the **written report** counts about 50% and your **own suggestions** 10%.
